Suncoast Voices for Children Foundation, Inc., was granted the non-profit 'public charity' status of 501 (c)(3) by the U.S. Internal Revenue Service in 2004. We have been assigned the EIN/TIN of 20-1133518. The EIN, or Employer Identification Number, is also known as a federal Tax Identification Number (TIN), and is used to identify a business or nonprofit entity. An EIN is a unique 9-digit number, similar to a Social Security Number for an individual. This number will be included in receipts for your contributions, for your tax filing purposes.

We are committed to maintaining very low expenses, as reflected in our IRS tax filings. You will notice that the latest return posted is for fiscal year 2013. We have recently concluded our Annual Audit of fiscal year 2014, and these documents will be available here as soon as they are certified and accepted.

Suncoast Voices for Children is led by an all-volunteer Board of Directors of 16 people from different backgrounds but with a common interest in preventing abuse and neglect, protecting at-risk children and providing for the unment needs of these children. Directors come from the Guardian ad Litem program of the Florida's 6th Judicial Circuit, the School System, other child-related non-profits and local businesses. These generous supporters do not officially represent their organizations, but give of their personal time and energy. The Presiding Officer (usually the President) is required to poll all Directors for any potential conflict of interest prior to the start of any meeting. Each potential Director must agree to policies of strict, conservative governance as laid out in the Code of Conduct and Disclosure form. The Guiding Priciples of this document are:
